- *Associates Degree in Medical Imaging*
- *Certified or eligible to complete the certification in ARRT, ARDMS, NMTCB*
- *Apply to the University of New Mexico Office of Admissions*
- *Seek Radiologic Sciences Program advisement*
- *Cumulative GPA 2.5 or higher*
- *Program preferred GPA 3.2 - 4.0+*
